Frank Lawler

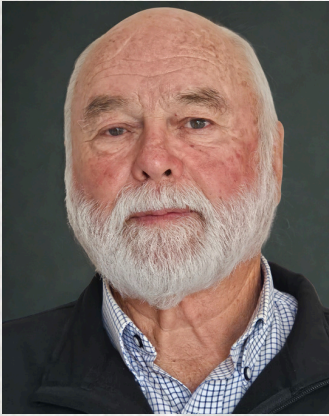
Current director since 2023. Studied up to Diploma Level Business Administration at University of Newcastle. Franks business interests include:
